Introduction of new Public Works Director: Paul Trombino

Bikeway Project with DDA: Allison Baxter

This is a pilot project with the DDA and funds from CDOT. The goal of this project is to create a path/trail from the Poudre Trail to the Downtown area and UNC to Downtown. The UNC trail will go north on 10th Ave, and 7th Ave all the way to Downtown, these two streets were chosen because of less auto traffic. From there cyclist will have to take 11th Ave all the way to D St to connect with Poudre Trail. The trail will have "Greeley Bikeways" signage for cyclists.

Transit Update: Will Jones

Darren Davis, Transit Manager, left the City in May and Melvin Barkley will be replacing him. He will start July 12th. He comes with tremendous experience. He is coming from St Louis where he was the Assistant General Manager

Transportation Construction Update: Tom Hellen

- East 8th St is moving along. Concrete work on the south side of the intersection has been completed. The project will be completed in August
- 35th Ave project. C St by the ditch is closed and the roundabout will be opening up soon. Working with Xcel Energy to switch light poles to underground service.
- Overlay is underway, working at 71st Ave and the Downtown area
- Chip seal is being done in the western area

All present board members unanimously approved the by-laws update

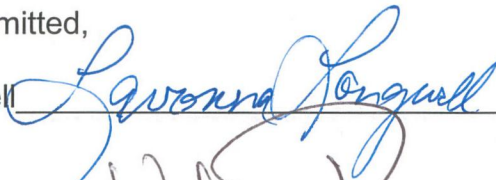

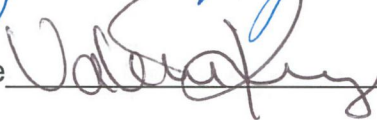
