IV. PUBLIC COMMENT

O St & 59th Ave Overview and Input: Tom Hellen

The roundabout design is in process; the plan includes merge in-lanes, two-lane paths, and medians. This is a CDOT funded project, in the process of acquiring right-of-way. Construction will start 2022

O St & 35th Ave Overview: Tom Hellen

The design is being done by Weld County to ensure it will meet the needs of urban and rural travelers. The roundabout will be made of concrete to provide a longer life with a wider diameter to better accommodate the needs of large trucks and agricultural vehicles with streetlights for improved visibility at night

35th Ave Roadway Project Update: Tom Hellen

- The concrete walls have been poured
- F St will be milled in the middle of April
- 4th St going north, widening of street
- Project will be finished this fall including extra widening all the way to F St that was added with the extra funding

Transportation Construction Update: Tom Hellen

- Work started for a right turn lane at Centerplace by Safeway
- E 8th St is under construction, concrete from the Highway all the way to Ash Ave will start in the summer
- Design of traffic signal light on 20th St at AIMS Welcome Center entrance with construction to start late summer
- Active Adult Center's concrete work and lighting pedestals have been completed. Warm weather needed for final base and paving and it is set to reopen in June
- Development plan being done at 83rd Ave and 37th St on the Evans side, scheduled to be done late summer/early fall
- 6th St between 9th Ave and 10th Ave, KGM road improvement, on-street parking for the businesses and driveway access, curb and gutter, concrete work, and stripping

- Quiet zones: the application to the PUC for the removal of tracks at 5th, 8th and 10th of the Great Western has been submitted , hoping to get this done by middle of June
- City of Evans is starting construction on the south end of the City on 47th Ave.
- Upcoming: design of 83rd Ave between 10th St and 12th St (CDOT funded) for turn lanes, road improvements and adapting a traffic signal.
- 16th St between 7th Ave and 11th Ave by UNC revitalizing road improvements
