January 28, 2020

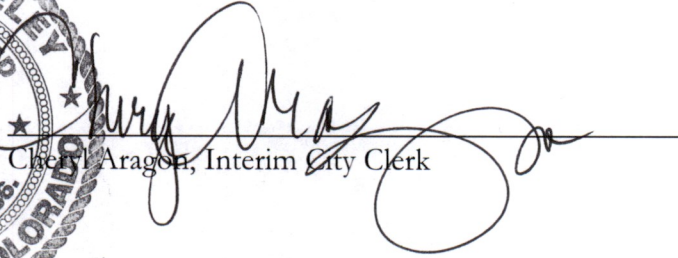
The Worksession began at 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, January 28, 2020, in Council's Chambers, 1001 11th Avenue.
