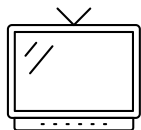
City Council members may participate in this meeting via electronic means pursuant to their adopted policies and protocol.

Meetings are televised live on GTV8 on cable television.

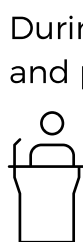

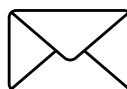
