

**GOLF ADVISORY BOARD
MEETING MINUTES – November 4, 2021**

1. ROLL CALL

The Golf Advisory Board met on Thursday, November 4, at 4:36 p.m. in person at the Family Funplex and via Zoom. Board members present; Andrew Clark, Adam Klett, Cherilyn Barringer, Larry Turk, Keagan Dollard, and Billy Grady. Board members absent; Tory Hanson. Staff present; Wayne Leighton (Golf Manager), John Lambrecht (Superintendent- Boomerang Links), and Dwight Staats (Superintendent- Highland Hills). Public present: Tommy Sporleder, Tyler Kaul, and Justin Clark.

2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Billy Grady made a motion to approve the minutes for September, The Motion was seconded by Larry Turk and passes 6-0.

3. PUBLIC INPUT

Tommy S presented to board members a proposition to add a memorial bench at Boomerang Links golf course. Tommy, Tyler, and Justin have turned in plans to the City of Greeley and wanted the board's input. The board discussed the issue for some time. The next steps are to await approval from the City of Greeley. John Lambrecht stated they would be coming up with some policies for memorial items at each golf course.

John Lambrecht- Mr. Lambrecht notified board members that maintenance staff was working on end-of-season duties and the City of Greeley will be starting on the new restrooms at Boomerang hopefully over the winter months.

Dwight Staats- Mr. Staats reported Highland Hills maintenance crew is working on winter cup cutting and they will be blowing out irrigation on November 15th and 16th.

6. NEW BUSINESS

Billy Grady made a motion to accept the memorial bench plan, Larry Turk seconded the motion. All in favor passed 6-0.

7. OLD BUSINESS

Construction Update - John Lambrecht reported that irrigation and seeding of hole #10 have been completed and are awaiting results before opening up the hole for play.

Personal Golf Cart Usage- The board had a lengthy discussion about allowing personal golf cart usage on both City courses. The board agreed it would not be a good fit for City of Greeley golf courses to allow personal golf carts on the courses.
