

**GOLF ADVISORY BOARD
MEETING MINUTES – September 9, 2021**

1. ROLL CALL

The Golf Advisory Board met on Thursday, September 9, at 4:33 p.m. in person at the Family Funplex and via Zoom. Board members present; Andrew Clark, Tory Hanson, Adam Klett, Cherlyn Barringer, Larry Turk, and Billy Grady. Board members absent; Keagan Dollard. Staff present; Andy McRoberts (CPRD Director), Wayne Leighton (Golf Manager), John Lambrecht (Superintendent- Boomerang Links), and Dwight Staats (Superintendent- Highland Hills). Public present: Troy Kyne and Scott McPherson.

2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Andy Clark made a motion to approve the minutes for July, The Motion was seconded by Bill Grady and passes 6-0.

3. PUBLIC INPUT

Troy Kyne presented to the board allowing personal golf carts to be used on the City of Greeley golf courses. Mr. Kyne believes allowing this would help bring more patrons and funds to the golf courses. There was a brief discussion on this topic. Wayne Leighton will research this through the City Attorneys and other municipal golf courses on the Front Range.

5. STAFF REPORTS

Wayne Leighton- Mr. Leighton stated there were over 324 rounds played at both courses over Labor Day weekend. Mr. Leighton mentioned the ValPak coupon will continue through September for 9 holes at Boomerang. Mr. Leighton updated the board on current golf rounds at each golf course. Mr. Leighton reported due to the construction at Boomerang several events and tournaments were moved to Highland Hills.

John Lambrecht- Mr. Lambrecht notified board members on 9/2 he aerified Boomerang and his staff is working on late summer maintenance.

Dwight Staats- Mr. Staats reported Highland Hills had aerified one week before Boomerang and that his maintenance staff is preparing for fall.

6. NEW BUSINESS

November Board Meeting- Changed date from the 11th to the 4th of November due to Holiday.

New Bathrooms Facilities at Boomerang – Mr. Lambrecht announced there would be two new restroom facilities at Boomerang Links by holes #7 & #13. These new facilities will be ADA compliant. In addition, they will have heating for all year usage and bottle fillers for cold water. Mr. Staats is looking into installing bottle fillers of cold water at the existing outside restrooms at Highland. This would replace the drinking water cooler stations on the golf course.

Mr. Leighton added the drinking water coolers at Highland are no longer on the course. The drinking fountains at each outside restroom on Highland Hills GC are operational.

7. OLD BUSINESS

Construction Update - John Lambrecht reported that holes 11, 12 & 13 are almost mature enough to be open for play. Mr. Lambrecht mentioned his staff re-seeded hole #10. Mr. Lambrecht told board members the pump station facility and installation of the irrigation laterals are almost finished. Mr. Lambrecht added that in the following weeks they will be back flowing and adding cobble to the lakes which should be completed within the next 3-4 weeks. Andy McRoberts commented that the City of Greeley has an agreement with District 6 to turn over some property by January 1. In January the back 9 holes at Boomerang will be shut down to complete this project.
