 - a. Uptown Trees 2021-2022 – Staff and the Uptown Tree Committee are recommending three artists who each submitted a 3-D model to scale of their proposed design. The selection committee reviewed models on Dec. 2 and after all follow up questions were answered by the artist to the satisfaction of the committee the 3D models shown today are the committee's top three choices to have installed in June 2022. ACTION: Vote to accept the three recommended artists' proposals to be fabricated and installed along 8th Avenue for the amount of \$12,000 each.

 - b. 2023 Art Master Plan – please let Kim know if you are interested in assisting the RAMP committee with the development of our next Art Master Plan. Monthly meetings will begin in January, 2022 and go through October to accomplish this important task.

7. Project Reports:

- a. 12 St Storm Water Outfall – The committee agreed to invite Adam Kuby and Joshua Wiener to the final round jury for interviews. One final artist will be contracted to Design & Build a sculpture to be developed alongside of the 12th St Storm Outfall project team in 2022 and installed in 2023.
- b. Migration/Transformation new purchase - the Stained glass mosaic sculpture by Annette Coleman has been installed on the corner of 9th Ave and 8th St.; minor adjustments are needed before the purchase is final. The 'Feather' sculpture has been temporarily moved to 9th Ave and 9th St until spring when Kirk Seese picks it up.
- c. Fire Station #6 – in progress
- d. IG Trailhead Marker Art – A contract is being negotiated with the artist.
- e. Paint the Town
 - i. Greeley Funplex pool mural – a Selection Committee meeting will be set in January
 - ii. New Rodarte Bus Wrap – on hold

Dik Munson called the meeting to order.

A motion to approve the October minutes was made by Tom Devore and seconded by Eddie Mirick. The October minutes were approved unanimously.

New Business and Action Items:

1. A recommendation to deaccession ‘Urban Art Deco’ Alleyway Mural by Zach Keiss was further discussed. Robb Casseday motioned to approve the second and final vote for the deaccession process. Tom DeVore seconded and the motion was unanimously approved.
2. The recommendation to purchase ‘Migration/Transformation’ by Annette Coleman with Art Acquisition funds was discussed. Sandy Magnuson motioned to approve the purchase of ‘Migration/Transformation’ for \$12,000. Rob Casseday seconded and the motion was unanimously approved.
3. A request was made for the Art Commission to consider adding new mural projects in the swimming pool area at the Greeley Family Funplex. Tom Devore motioned to approve adding new murals in the Greeley Funplex pool area in 2022. Eddie Mirick seconded and the motion was unanimously approved.

Project Reports:

- d. Uptown Trees 2021-2022 –Four artists have agreed to submit a 3-D model to scale of their proposed design. Each artists will receive \$300 for completing their final submission. The selection committee will review models on Dec. 2, 2021.
- e. 12 St Storm Outfall –An RFQ has been posted to Café to solicit an artist with a deadline of November 16. .
- f. Kim begun attending meetings on the 16th St corridor project (8th Ave to 10th Ave); this project is now active again with a tentative schedule of design in 2022 and construction/ art installation in 2023.
- g. Fire Station #6 – in progress
- h. Paint the Town
- i. Excel Energy Utility Cabinets – Our point of contact is changing and we expect that to slow down the progress.
- j. IG Trailhead Marker Art – No changes
- k. New Rodarte Bus Wrap – on hold
