7. Project Reports:

- a. The Ramp Committee had an early discussions on
 - i. Possible replacement of the bus wrap 'Every Drop Counts' when the Rodarte Center purchases replacement buses.
 - ii. Possible relocation of 'Sanctuary', the little treehouse, before construction of Foundation Hall begins.
 - iii. 2023 AMP ideas – time to start brainstorming; staff thoughts include Delta Park in East Greeley, East Memorial Park with Natural area Phase II improvements,
- b. Coloring Books – Books are being printed and will be distributed in March.
- c. Utility Cabinets- Final Ward II locations have been approved by the Streets department. The artist proposals are due by March 31 and will be juried in April.
- d. InStall Art – nothing to report.
- e. Winds of Change II – No Changes- Art is scheduled to be installed July 2020.
- f. East Greeley Park Art/Chair Danyelle – No changes. Art installations for Balsam Park and the Natural Area are projected for September/October 2021.

New Business

1. 2021 Coloring Books –
 - a. Ed Rogers presented the 2021 coloring book to the committee showing illustrations by Ann Martinez. The book requires some changes to wording, but then is ready to send to the printer and be distributed to third graders in March. Louisa Anderson motioned for a conditional vote of approval that was seconded by Robb Casseday. The motion was passed unanimously.
2. Posting Site for Committee Notices
 - a. The City of Greeley mandate requires a posting site be designated by each Board and Commission for public notices. Ed Rogers recommended designating the City of Greeley website www.greeleygov.com as the primary site for notices, and City Hall Lobby at 1000 10th St. be noted as the secondary site. Dik Munson motioned to approve with Louisa Anderson seconding. The resolution was passed unanimously.
