Guest Presentation

1. Sean Chamber and Adam Jokerst from the City of Greeley Water and Sewer Department submitted a presentation on the Terry Ranch water storage project. This presentation focused on water storage for Greeley's future water needs and how a ground water aquifer will help. A discussion was held on the costs and how a decision was made to move on with this project.

New Business

1. Vote for New Officer –
 - a. A secret ballot will be held to elect a new officer. The vote will be held through emails, which will be coordinated by Kim Snyder.
2. Sculpture on Loan
 - a. The Sculpture on Loan subcommittee recommends the purchase of “Feathers” by Kirk Seese for \$15,250. A Motion to Approve was made by Robb Casseday, and approved by Thomas Devore. The motion was passed unanimously.
3. Review Summary of Data from the assessment of Public Art in Greeley by UNC intern Sean Zimny
 - a. A discussion was held on the research conducted by Sean Zimny, noting that the work can help focus future projects. Gender and past trends were discussed and how or if those factors need to be considered when awarding future projects.
