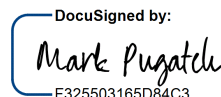
Union Colony Civic Center Advisory Board

February 10, 2021 3:48 pm Via Zoom

1. The meeting was called to order.
 - a. Board present: Mark Pugatch, Craig Montgomery, Ken Andrews, Deanna Terry, Alison Hamling, and Perry Bell, Michelle Saunder, Debra Brilla
 - b. Board absent: Cher Heimbegner
 - c. Staff present: Jason Evenson, Jill Droegmueller, Brady Wager and Andy McRoberts
 - d. Guests present: Sean Chambers, Adam Jokerst
2. Additions/deletions to the Agenda – None
3. Approved minutes-Changes to the minutes were submitted by Mark Pugatch including changing the name UCStars to UCCC Backstage Stars. Motion to approve as amended was made by Perry Bell and seconded by Deanna Terry, the motion was passed unanimously.
4. New Business
 - a. Sean Chambers and Adam Jokerst introduced the guild to the Terry Ranch project, a groundwater aquifer that will act as water storage to help manage the growing Greeley Populations water needs. The committee discussed water credits, and water quality questions and other factors for the plan.
 - b. The Union Colony Civic Center was awarded \$50,000 from a Colorado Arts Relief grant.
 - c. The UCCC held a two day rental which utilized the new signage and gated entry systems. Because of the new covid-19 restrictions a reduced rental rate is in use. This rental also utilized the new streaming service to sell tickets to those who could not attend in person. There were some buffering and connecting issues that staff are working on correcting, a recommendation has been made to the tenant to re-stream the events at no cost to the patrons or tenant.
 - d. New signage was created showing where to enter the theatre for specific seats, along with mask and hand sanitizing requirements have been installed and are working effectively.
 - e. The Advisory Board discussed locations to designate as the official posting site for posting Board information. A motion to designate the City of Greeley website as the primary posting location and the City of Greeley City Hall lobby as a backup site was made by Mark Pugatch and seconded by Alison Hamling. The motion was approved unanimously.
5. Old/Ongoing Business
 - a. The UCCC is currently attempting to reschedule Lance Burton and Friends and Rick Springfield. The Sugar Skulls have been dropped from the 2021 schedule. The Oakridge Boys and Amy Grant are still on the table for rebooking with more information to come.
 - b. In-Install Art Subcommittee- Craig Montgomery updated the committee on a design being accepted. Julie Dillon's designs will start installation in the beginning of March.
 - c. Diversity sub-committee –No report.
 - d. UCCC Backstage Stars- (Perry) Perry reported on the addition of a new brochure rack and a magnetic display that was installed in the UCCC lobby. There are also two new televisions, one in the Family Funplex and another in the Ice Haus. The Televisions will show information on Recreation and Culture division programs. The UCCC Backstage Stars is looking for ways to recognize UCCC volunteers. A memorial recognizing volunteer service is in consideration.
