 - Wrap up to ten Traffic cabinets this year (we wrapped 5 cabinets last year)
 - Add art, possibly vinyl wraps, to metal enclosures around alley art dumpsters requested by city Public Works Dept.
 - Collaborate with the DDA to replace 'Courage Mural.'

The owners of the building are now ready to scrap the old stucco, including the 'Courage' mural, and add new stucco. The DDA is discussing the installation of a new mural with the original artists, Armando Silva and Wes Sam Bruce when the building wall is in good repair. They have asked if the Art Commission would like to help fund the new mural at 50% (\$12,500)

5. Project Reports:

- a. Redtail Park – the first meeting was held to explain the overview of the project. (see map attached)
- b. Delta Park- we are in the process of contracting with Armando Silva to design and create artwork. The design team would like to see something like an archway at the north entrance to the park. The community will be involved with the design.
- c. Discovery Bay Vinyl Wrap- waiting for warmer Spring Weather.
- d. 12th St outfall- on schedule, no updates.
- e. 16th St- on schedule, no updates.

6. Maintenance & Repair

- a. 'Art & Soul', the white Yule Marble installation in front of the UCCC by artist Madeline Wiener, has been cleaned.
- b. 'Building Seas', an aluminum sculpture located in Centennial Park has been repaired by Precision Welding. They are also welding an 18-inch-high pedestal for the piece to give it more height.
- c. The 2023 Uptown Tree located at LINC has chipped paint where two pieces are rubbing in the wind. The artwork is still under warranty and the artist will be in Greeley in May to touch up paint and amend the artwork so the scraping will not continue. Other

- a. Tointon Gallery Exhibit: 'Changing Landscapes: Transformative Observations Through printmaking' is an exhibit celebrating the month of printmaking. The exhibit will be up through April 26th.
- b. The upcoming exhibit opening, and artist reception will be held on May 3 from 5-7pm. L I M I N A L is a collection of encaustic works by Boulder-based artist Anne Feller. She describes her process of layering as a method of preservation which reflects her concerns surrounding the mortality of the people, the moment, and the memory depicted within her works.

2. Approval of February minutes:

3. New Business:

- The courage mural was painted on the building of 8th ave and 7th street. The owners have decided to renovate the wall so the mural can be replaced. The DDA is talking with the original artists to paint a new mural after the wall is in good repair. They have asked if the Art Commission would be interested in collaborating with them on the project. This item was tabled for the paint the town committee.
- A committee was made for the artwork design of Red Tail Park. Sharon Wright and Molly McIntosh volunteered to serve on the committee.
- Kim presented a new inventory system called Public Art Archive. This new system will store the entire collection with pictures and a small description for all to see.

Motion to consider pursuing the new inventory system made by Tom Devore and seconded by Molly McIntosh.

Motion passed unanimously.

- A new street mural project was presented for the corner of 7th ave and 16th st in partnership with Atlas theatre/Ambry owners, and Public Works. They have submitted their design for an intersection street mural. Public Works will oversee

the maintenance and repair of the painting; it will not be in the Public Art Inventory. Art Commission is asked to approve the design only; no additional action will be needed for this project.

Motion to approve street mural project design made by Tony Miller and seconded by Eddie Mirick.

Motion passed unanimously.

- The commission read the project report before the meeting. The chairperson, Louisa Andersen asked if there were any questions.
- There were no questions about the upcoming projects.
