1. The meeting was called to order by Louisa Andersen at 4:02 p.m.

2. Approval of March Minutes:

Motion to approve the April minutes made by Kathy Sage and seconded by Heather Ultrata.

Motion passed unanimously.

3. New Business:

- Tabled-Guest Presenter until July
- Red Tail Park – Josh Bales has submitted his final design.

Move to approve the final design made by Kathy Sage and seconded by Sharon Wright.

Motion passed unanimously.

- Delta Park- Armando Silva has come up with 3 designs for the park. The commission looked through a presentation. Clint Anders wants to include all 3 designs and expand the budget to purchase all 3. The goal is to get feedback from the commission for this project. There was talk about making sure that the sculptures are not seen as a playground. Idea to also make sure that the sculptures are cohesive to one another. Make sure to keep accessibility in mind when making the benches, or a cut out in the bench to have someone in a wheelchair be able to sit there. Another idea is to have varying levels.

4. Project Reports:

- The commission read the project report before the meeting. The chairperson, Louisa Andersen asked if there were any questions. There was discussion on the following items:

- The 12th ST outfall instillation project was discussed. The commission looked at photos from the current installation, and discussed what the final project was going to look like.
- The 2023 Uptown tree at LINC had chipped paint where two pieces were rubbing together in the wind. The paint was touched up and a new bar was inserted to add stability in the wind to prevent this from happening again.
- The old furniture store building on 8th Ave between 10th and 11th St, east side of the street. After an inspection by the city, they have designated an immediate or ASAP demolition due to the roof falling in during the storm, causing the walls to no longer be supported. There are two uptown trees on the block in front of the building we must get removed ASAP. Kim stated she is working with Will Jones to make that happen.
- There were no questions about the upcoming projects.

5. Other:

- Weld Walls, which is being funded by an ARPA grant will be hosted at Weldwerks campus on Sept 17-21.
