2. There was a Food Tax presentation given by city staff.

3. Approval of June 2024 minutes:

Motion to approve the June 2024 minutes made by Molly McIntosh and seconded by Tom Devore.

Motion Passed unanimously.

4. Courage Mural discussion:

- Armando Silva is now doing the courage mural by himself, and so he resubmitted his design. The final cost for the mural is 35,000. The Art Commission will be contributing 50% of the cost to make 17,500.
- There was a recommendation from the art commission to add in an Aims Community College design type, since they felt like the bear represented UNC.
- There was another recommendation to move the words up a few feet so that cars in the parking lot don't block the words.
- There was also another recommendation to change the lettering of the "D" because it reminded the group about the Detroit Tigers.

Motion to accept the updated mural concept and contribute 17,500 made by Heather Utrata and seconded by Molly McIntosh.

Motion passed Unanimously.

5. The Delta Park update was skipped due to there not being an update ready to propose to the Art Commission.
6. Triennial Review is due August 1st. The reviews need to be given to Louisa by the end of the weekend.
7. Arts Picnic Booth signups are live to booth sit. There was discussion about having a creative project or things to hand out to bring people to the booth.
