Paint the Town Selection Committee

Greeley Art Commission

April 3, 2024, at 10:30 a.m.

Cultural Affairs Office at the Greeley Recreation Center

1. The meeting was called to order by Kim Snyder at 10:34 a.m.

2. New Business:

- We have committed to installing 5 new traffic cab art wraps this year. We have an abundance of good designs in from our CAFÉ call. It might be wise to consider installing 10 new traffic cab art wraps this year. I saw several that would be good in other areas of town (other than 10th St) such as near Island Grove. IF we install 10 this year, we will have a remaining balance of \$36,925 for murals (shown on page 2).
 - The selection committee unanimously agreed recommending to the Art Commission the wrapping up to ten traffic cabinets this year.
- New mural to replace existing 'Courage' mural – The DDA has begun working with the original artists, Armando Silva and Wes Sam Bruce, to paint a new mural after the building wall is in good repair. They have asked if the Art Commission would be interested in collaborating with them on the mural. This would include some project management assistance from staff, design approval and funding. A design with a budget has not yet been submitted. The DDA would like us to contribute our standard amount with them which is 50% of the funding (this mural is estimated at 25,000). The GAC contribution would be \$12,500 for the artwork.
 - The selection committee unanimously agreed to recommend to the Art Commission that we contribute up to \$12,500 to collaborate with the DDA on a new Armando Silva/Wes Sam Bruce mural on the outside wall of the Wonderhands Studio.
- Art Alleyway dumpster enclosures – the city is discussing a grant they received to enclose the dumpsters in the alley. They called to ask if we might have some funding to add art to them in leu of the art on the walls that will no longer be seen. The enclosures will be metal and could possibly be wrapped.

- The selection committee unanimously agreed to recommend to the Art Commission that we investigate the scope including costs to adopt this project in whole or in part with the DDA.
