2. Maintenance & Repair
 - a. The Moire’ Tree by David Farquharson was found on the sidewalk near 14th St. Public Works staff were the first to report it but we also had three caring citizens let us know it was down. The artwork was created in two pieces and half of the metal pole/trunk is still in the planter. The top portion with the art attached was taken to the Parks yard and then picked up by the artist the following day. 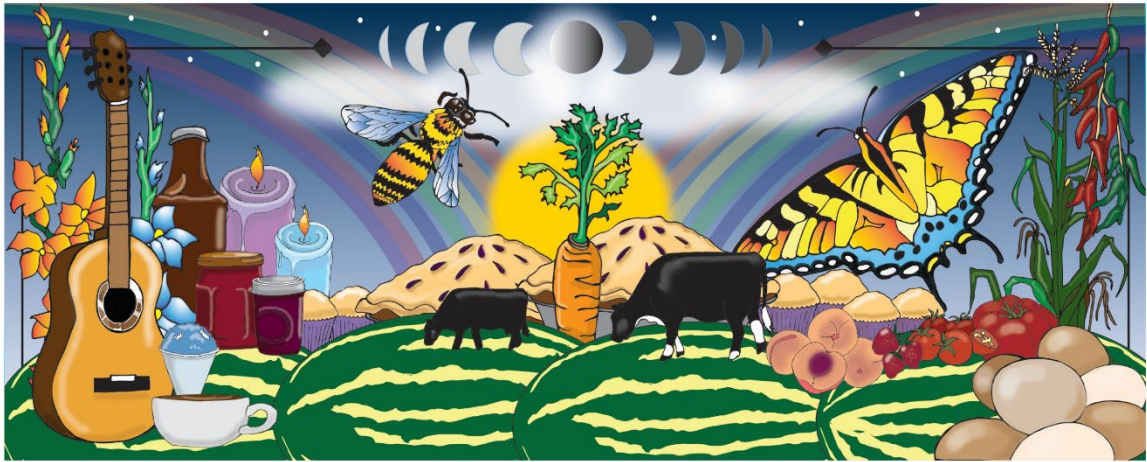
Motion to purchase Autumn Dream, and Green River Study 1 and 2 made by Sharon Wright and seconded by Molly McIntosh.
