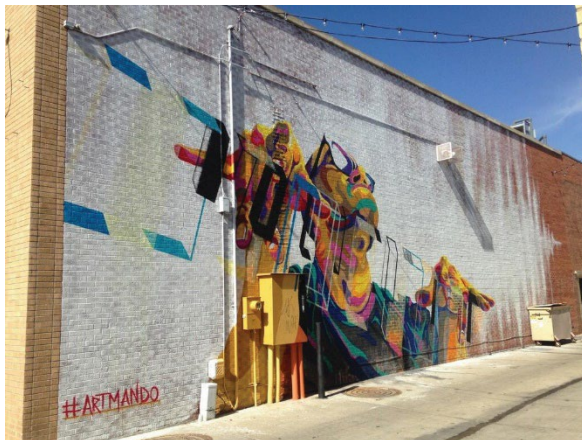

3. Approval of March, Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> Minutes
4. Meeker House Projection Art Update open for discussion. A vote to approve the scope of the project is needed to move forward.
5. Paint the town new murals as part of Weld Works celebration discussion. Two murals are up for replacement in the alley: 1) Armando Silva- 'Greeley on My Mind' and 2) Brandon Malaty- 'Jazz Percussionist'. Staff recommends using \$20,000 for murals in the alleyway in September 2025. We currently have \$50,00 in the Paint the Town fund and the remaining dollars will go towards the dumpster enclosures in the Alleyway.



6. 16<sup>th</sup> St – Meetings are once again in progress. The site contractors will pour 24-inch round foundations for three works of art. Mario will install them at the soonest in September; the installation is contingent upon construction schedules staying on time.



- a. One work of art will be removed/relocated for the reconstruction of 16<sup>th</sup> Street. 'Cloudrain II' was purchased from Jeffie Brewer in 2014 for \$5,500 from our Sculpture on Loan program (which no longer exists in Greeley). It has been repainted once and is peeling again and beginning to rust. Staff suggests we donate this piece to the D6 Chappelow Arts Magnet School for their students to paint it on a regular basis as needed IF they will accept it. In 2015 the sculpture titled 'Beefalo' by Gregory Bergman was donated to the D6 Greeley Central Arts Magnet School because the maintenance would be too high if it were placed in a public area.

1. Project Reports:
  - a. Paint the Town – 2025 funds will be used towards wrapping Art Alleyway dumpster enclosures with art. Possible commitment to Weld Walls 2025 to update some murals in the alleyway in September.
  - b. Delta Park – Moving forward with two 'Totem' sculptures. Costs and materials have been confirmed.
  - c. Redtail Park – A location has been selected, and Josh Bales will install the artwork in the next several weeks.
