



Liquor Licensing Authority Minutes

Friday, October 18, 2024 – 1:00 p.m.

Virtual Hearing via Zoom Webinar

1. **Call to order**

Liquor Licensing Authority, Mark Gonzales called the meeting to order at 1:00 p.m. The meeting was conducted virtually via Zoom.

2. Public Hearing to consider a Transfer of Ownership for an existing Retail Liquor Store Liquor License Application:

Manreet Kaur was present. Sunita Sharma represented the City Attorney's Office. Judge Gonzales asked if wholesaler affidavits had been received. Ms. Kaur reported she had two more to obtain. Judge Gonzales asked Ms. Sharma what she thought about the situation, and she asked if the transfer could be granted conditionally. Judge Gonzales said he preferred to continue the hearing to November 1st. He asked Ms. Sharma and Ms. Kaur if 2:00 p.m. would work and continued the hearing to November 1st pending the receipt of the rest of the wholesaler affidavits.

Mike Moreno, owner of Whiskey Pete's was present. Lucas Corliss represented the City Attorney's Office. Judge Gonzales asked Mr. Corliss for an update regarding this matter. Mr. Corliss said Mr. Moreno told him he received an update from the State LED that Gorilla Liquor had withdrawn their Transfer application, but Mr. Corliss had not been able to confirm that with the State LED office yet. Mr. Corliss also thought Mr. Moreno had applied to transfer the license instead of a renewal.

Judge Gonzales set the item over to the November 15, 2024 Hearing. He asked Mr. Moreno if he had any questions. Mr. Moreno explained that he had contacted the State, and Brittany with the State LED sent an email stating the State did not show Gorilla Liquor as the holder of the license. Mr. Moreno also stated he was attempting to get in touch with Mr. Corliss prior to the Hearing. Judge Gonzales said as far as he was concerned the transfer was completed. Mr. Moreno wanted to know what he needed to do, and Judge Gonzales advised he consult an attorney.

Judge Gonzales said without the transfer he had to apply for a new license.

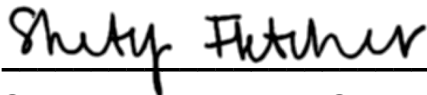
