4. Meeker House Projection Art - Update and Discussion: A vote to approve the scope of the project is needed to move forward.
5. One work of art has been removed/relocated for the reconstruction of 16th Street. 'Cloudrain II' was purchased from Jeffie Brewer in 2014 for \$5,500 from our Sculpture on Loan program (which no longer exists in Greeley). It has been repainted once and is peeling again and beginning to rust. Staff suggests and artist agrees that we donate this piece to the D6 Chappelow Arts Magnet School for their students to paint it on a regular basis as needed IF they will accept it. In 2015 the sculpture titled 'Beefalo' by Gregory Bergman was donated to the D6 Greeley Central Arts Magnet School because the maintenance would be too high if it were placed in a public area.



6. New Project – 15th Ave Ct Underpass Art: We need two volunteers to sit on a committee with other stakeholders to set a scope for the proposed project to bring to the full GAC for approval to move forward. These volunteers could also be on the Merge project for the 35th Ave overpass project.

 - b. Delta Park – Moving forward with two ‘Totem’ sculptures. Costs and materials have been confirmed.
