4. Wastewater Treatment Plant Art - The volunteer Art Commissioners and staff met to discuss budget and timeline. They are recommending an overall budget of \$113,000 with \$80,000 going to the one contracted artist. A committee with stakeholders will be selected to move forward drafting the RFQ and to Jury after submissions are in. A vote to approve is needed from the Art Commission to move forward.
5. New Project – 15<sup>th</sup> Ave Ct Underpass Art: We need two volunteers to sit on a committee with other stakeholders to set a scope for the proposed project to bring to the full GAC for approval to move forward. These volunteers could also be on the Merge project for the 35<sup>th</sup> Ave overpass project.

1. Project Reports:
  - a. Paint the Town –
    - i. 2025 funds will be used towards wrapping Art Alleyway dumpster enclosures with art. Call to artist has been posted regional through social media.
    - ii. The commitment to Weld Walls 2025 to update murals in the alleyway in September has been confirmed in the amount of \$20,000.
  - b. Delta Park – Moving forward with two ‘Totem’ sculptures. Costs and materials have been confirmed.
  - c. 16<sup>th</sup> St – Meetings are once again in progress. The site contractors will pour 24-inch round foundations for three works of art. Mario will install them at the soonest in September; the installation is contingent upon construction schedules staying on time.
  - d. Redtail Park – A location has been selected, and Josh Bales has installed the artwork.

  - a. The Moire’ Tree by David Farquharson pending
  - b. Art is the Point mural by Eleanore Yates – will commence by Mario Echevarria when weather allows

1. The meeting was called to order by Louisa Andersen at 4:05 p.m.

2. Commission members went around the room and introduced themselves.
3. Approval of the March 2025 minutes made by Heather Utrata and seconded by Tony Miller.

Motion passed: 8 in favor, 1 abstention. Kendra Albee abstained.

4. Presentation of possible Meeker House Projection Art open for discussion. Vote is needed to approve the scope of the project.
  - Subcommittee (Heather Utrata, Molly McIntosh) presented their findings on the costs of the project, and their recommendation to do a one-time special event for 1,200.

Motion to approve purchase of one-time special event for 1200 made by Tom Devore and seconded by Michelle Booren.

Motion passed: 8 in favor, 1 abstention. Kendra Albee abstained.

5. Weld wall festival: Staff recommends using \$20,000 for murals in the alleyway in September 2025.
  - The commission discussed the murals and recommended that they have design approval beforehand.

Motion to approve the \$20,000 to contract 2 new murals made by Heather Utrata and seconded by Sharon Wright.

Motion passed: 8 in favor, 1 abstention. Kendra Albee abstained.

6. Artwork "Cloudrain II" has been recommended by staff to donate this piece to D6 Chappelow Arts Magnet School for students to paint.
  - Discussion was held and it was decided that there needs to be confirmation if the school would want the art piece or not.

Motion to approve the donation of "Cloudrain II" to Chappelow, on the grounds that the school accepts the donation made by Sharon Wright and seconded by Molly McIntosh.

Motion passed unanimously.

7. Project Reports:

- Louisa went to the D6 board meeting to present the coloring books. The books are still being printed but should be ready any day.
- Redtail Park: The location has been selected, and Josh Bales will install the artwork in the next several weeks.
- 16<sup>th</sup> St: The artist will be installing the artwork in September.
