- a. 16th St – Meetings are once again in progress. The site contractors will pour 24-inch round foundations for three works of art. Mario will install them at the soonest in September; the installation is contingent upon construction schedules staying on time.
- b. Paint the Town – 2025 funds will be used towards wrapping Art Alleyway dumpster enclosures and to Weld Walls 2025 to update some murals in the alleyway in September.

2. Approval of April 2025 minutes.

3. Wastewater Treatment Plant Art- The wastewater art committee presented their recommendation for an overall budget of \$113,000 with \$80,000 going to a contracted artist. The committee with stakeholders will be selected and start drafting the RFQ and to Jury submissions.

Motion for approval to move forward with the suggested \$113,000 budget made by Louisa Anderson and seconded by Molly McIntosh.

Motion passed unanimously.

4. New Project- 15th Ave underpass. Kim asked for 2 volunteers to sit on a committee to set a scope for the proposed project to bring to the full Art Commission for approval.

Perry Bell and Benson Verbel volunteered to be on the committee.

5. Presentation: Responses and follow up for Proposed Arts & Culture Commission. Megan Weiler, Cultural affairs division manager presented to each board and

commission, and gathered thoughts and comments. There was discussion between the commission on how to best go about this idea and brainstorming of other ideas.

6. Project Updates:

- Coloring Books went out late April.
- 16th Street: Mario Miguel brought back the design to the commission to remember the design. He will be completing this artwork soon. The construction company working on the street is going to be pouring the concrete bases for the sculpture.
- Arts Picnic: Booth sitting, and activity will be there. Will will do a mock-up to see how the design will be and practice before the Arts Picnic. We should get new banners, since last years were older.
