4. Guest Speaker - Presentation by the Greeley Legacy group to inform you of the awardees and organization purpose.

5. Water Treatment and Reclamation Art -The Committee recommends 3-5 artists to be to be short-listed for the project. They will be required to tour the facility and create a final proposal before the January 2026 GAC meeting. A vote to approve the short-listed artists is required to move forward.

6. The Parks Department has requested help in finding an artist to paint the basketball court once a new one has been constructed. They have funding, so moving forward with the project does not need GAC approval. Because the artwork will be on City Property, the design itself will need to be approved by the Art Commission. The committee would like to contract with an artist who will develop a design with Rodarte Kids input this fall and paint the design next Spring. The committee will present the selected artist to the GAC for approval and will also present the design when it is final before painting begins for approval. After completion, the Parks dept. would like to donate the artwork to Public Art for our inventory, care and maintenance of the artwork. Heather has volunteered to be on the committee, and we are looking for one more Art Commissioner.

7. Art Alleyway walkthrough artwork titled 'Spectrum' has been vandalized again. Should we be thinking about relocating the artwork?

have the artwork purchased. Molly suggested contacting members of the Kiwanis organization and seeing if they would want to have input on the artwork.

7. Arts Picnic Follow-up: Kuddos to Will Dillon for the hard work that he put into the booth, and the live painter was awesome. Next year there was an idea to have electricity for a fan because of the heat.
