City of Greeley Deputy City Attorney Moses Garcia and Butler Snow's Public Finance, Tax Incentive & Credit Market Attorney, Dalton Kelly were present.

Mr. McBroom provided a concise presentation to address the key points of a resolution concerning the West Greeley Residential General Improvement District (WGRGID). The objective is to establish a financial policy structure for the WGRGID. The resolution highlighted essential financial policies considered necessary for proper GID functionality.

Key points presented:

- **Mill Levy Cap:** The resolution proposed capping the mill levy at 15 mills within the Residential General Improvement District.
- **Revenue Authorization:** It authorized GID to receive revenues from specified sources and mandated that these revenues be allocated solely for debt service payments.

There were no questions from the Board.

Board Member McDonald moved to adopt the resolution. Board Member Payton seconded the motion. The motion passed 5-2 at 5:48 p.m. with Board Members Butler and DeBoutez voting “nay”.

The West Greeley Residential General Improvement District (WGRGID) was created by Ordinance 22, 2025 on August 19, 2025. Qualified electors approved up to 10 Mills for operating expenses and up to 20 Mills for debt service at the November 4, 2025 election. The resolution sets the mill levies at the following levels: 2 Mills for operating expenses and 10 Mills for debt service. This item is required to set the mill levies for 2025.

RESOLUTION NO. 3, SERIES 2025

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY OF GREELEY, RESIDENTIAL WEST GREELEY GENERAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT ESTABLISHING THE 2025 TAX LEVY AND DIRECTING CERTIFICATION TO THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

WHEREAS, the City of Greeley, Residential West Greeley General Improvement District (the "District") is a public improvement district and a quasi-municipal corporation duly organized pursuant to C.R.S. § 31-25-603 and Ordinance No., 22, 2025 of the City of Greeley, Colorado (the "City") adopted by the City Council of the City (the "City Council") on August 19, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the members of the City Council have been duly elected and qualified and serve *ex officio* as the Board of Directors of the District (the "board"); and

WHEREAS, at the election held on November 4, 2025 the qualified electors approved a mill levy not to exceed ten (10) mills for the purpose of paying the District's operations and maintenance expenses as the District is authorized by law to provide, including payments pursuant to Intergovernmental Agreements; and

WHEREAS, at the election held on November 4, 2025, the qualified electors approved an ad valorem property tax mill levy not to exceed twenty (20) mills for the purpose of paying the District's debt as the District is authorized by law to provide; and

WHEREAS, the Board has considered a proposed budget, and has considered the certificate from the Weld County Assessor showing the total assessed valuation of property subject to the ad valorem property tax by the District for the year of 2025 is \$558.00; and

WHEREAS, based upon consideration of the data referred to above, the Board has determined that the rate of taxation necessary to produce the required tax revenues for the 2026 budget is two (2) mills for operations and maintenance expenses and ten (10) mills for debt service.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY OF GREELEY, RESIDENTIAL WEST GREELEY GENERAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Tax Levy for Operations and Maintenance Expenses

The tax levy to be applied to the valuation of assessment of property subject to taxation by the District, is hereby established at 2 mills.

Section 2. Tax Levy for Debt Service

The tax levy to be applied to the valuation of assessment of property subject to taxation by the District, is hereby established at 10 mills.

Section 3. Certification to the Board of County Commissioners

The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to sign a statement certifying to the Board of County Commissioners that the tax levy for 2025 has been established at 12 mills.

A resolution of the Board of Directors of the City of Greeley, Residential West Greeley General Improvement District approving the 2026 Budget and appropriating funds

Summary:

The West Greeley Residential General Improvement District (WGRGID) was created by Ordinance 22, 2025 on August 19, 2025. Qualified electors approved up to 10 Mills for operating expenses and up to 20 Mills for debt at the November 4, 2025 election. The budget for WGRGID is based on 2 Mills for operating expenses and 10 Mills for debt service. This item is required for adoption and appropriation for the 2026 fiscal year. The initial appropriation for expenses in 2026 is zero (\$0). The expectation is that once the GID is able to issue debt staff will bring a budget amendment forward to the board to recognize the bond revenues and appropriate the bond proceeds to cover the cost of necessary infrastructure within the GID.
