1. Project Reports:

2. Approval of the October 2025 minutes.

3. Discussion on Public Art funds for performing arts.

- Background of this agenda item was given by Diana Frick, Director of Culture, Parks, and Recreation. On October 14, Diana Frick and Kelli Johnson came to council to present the art policy. This came from a request from a work session where Deb Debutez brought up some questions about the 1% art fund. Staff was asked to review the policy and present their findings to council. There was an idea mentioned that performing arts should be added under the scope of the 1%.
- There was discussion on the current policy, the policy has 70% of art funds reserved for art, 20% maintenance of art, 10% for administration.
- Discussion of the scope of the “performing arts” definition was held. What is a performing artist? Who would be eligible to apply for this money?
- How would this be changed? Council would have to change the charter and code.
- There was discussion with the commission on how to best handle the recommendation that the commission wants to bring. Louisa Andersen, Chair, prepared a letter in preparation for this discussion. The letter was passed out, and commission members had the chance to read.

- The idea and action item was for the commission members to listen to the presentation at the October 14th meeting. Agenda item for the next commission meeting is to prepare a memo in preparation for the next presentation Diana and Kelli will give on the art policy.
