Call to order

Liquor License Authority Mark Gonzales called the Hearing to order at 1:02 p.m. The Hearing was conducted virtually via Zoom.

Lucas Corliss was present from the City Attorney's Office. No one was present from Whiskey's LLC. Mr. Corliss stated he had spoken with the licensee, Ms. Milan, around 11 a.m. on November 7th, and she stated she would be present for the Hearing. Mr. Corliss provided a timeline for his communication with Ms. Milan and expressed frustration about her lack of appearance. He asked that Judge Gonzales find her in default for failure to appear. Judge Gonzales felt that Ms. Milan had been given proper notice of the Hearing and displayed a pattern of failure to appear on other Hearing dates. Because of this, Judge Gonzales sustained the motion issued by the City and asked Mr. Corliss to create an Order of Default with revocation of the license immediately upon signature of the Order.

The Order was signed and the license was revoked on November 24, 2025.




