Project Self-Sufficiency of Northern Colorado partners with low-income single parents in Larimer and Weld counties to help them build a clear career path, complete the college education or certification required, and secure a job in their chosen career field while empowering them through our staged SelfPower model. Recognizing that barriers to success can be overwhelming without support, we provide intensive, personalized guidance from highly skilled Program Advisors as well as wraparound support services in areas like housing, transportation, tuition, childcare, groceries, healthcare and more. In 2025, PS-S served 163 single parents with 276 children in Larimer and Weld counties.

1. The meeting was called to order by Daniel Knopf at 3:46 p.m.

2. Approval of the November 2025 minutes

Motion to approve the the November 2025 minutes made by Doran Azari and seconded by Robert Wasson.

Motion passed unanimously.

3. New Business:

- Ticket Donation Subcommittee Report: The sub-committee recommends that the board approve 4 tickets to Tusk for Built NOCO.

Motion to approve the recommendation of 4 tickets to tusk given to Built NOCO made by Danile Knopf and seconded by Perry Bell.

Motion passed unanimously.

4. Old Business:

- Stephen gave an update to the board about ticket sales, cost recovery, and upcoming shows. There was brief discussion about the family-oriented shows and how those shows are priced. Board members communicated that this is the best season in years, referring to the line-up of shows booked.

5. Other:

- Backstage Stars Report: No report.
 - Sign Relocation funding discussion.
 - Stephen gave a brief explanation to the city process and the priority of this item.
 - There was discussion about the boards stance on the survey results for the renaming of the UCCC.

Motion was made by Daniel Knopf that while the survey results were accepted, the acceptance of the survey results themselves was not an indication of an outcome, rather just an acceptance of facts. The relevant facets were that a survey was conducted, and the results of the survey were considered to be valid. The board would like to clarify that accepting the survey results doesn't equate to endorsing or opposing a name change, and the Board preserves the option for consideration and discussion of this matter in the future. Motion was seconded by Cathy Salaymeh.

Motion passed unanimously.
