### MINUTES

- I. **Call to Order:** Commissioner Amber Greene called the meeting to order at 4:05 pm. Other members present were Commissioners Jaiden Krause, Ryley Bowen, Tiffany Simons, Ricardo Perez, Councilor Deb DeBoutez, and City staff member Nelvis Alvarez.
  
- II. **Land Acknowledgment Statement:** *We hold this meeting on the traditional lands of the Ute, Cheyenne, and Arapaho peoples, as well as all other tribes that are historically tied to the State of Colorado. We value and respect the history and culture of our native and indigenous peoples, and as a community, we celebrate the legacy of the Elders and those who have been stewards of the land throughout the generations. The HRC is seeking the council of Native communities, to prioritize their voices, and offer a more complete view of the region's past, present, and future.*

      3. Priorities of the City of Greeley (based on survey results) – Road maintenance, traffic management, and enforcement of city codes and ordinances.
      4. Other findings, such as sources from which city residents currently receive information about the City of Greeley.
      5. After listening to the presentation, commissioners expressed that they will invest some time in going deeper into the survey PowerPoint and dashboard due to the amount of information the survey provides.
